Step #2 - iPad Connection

On your iPad go to Settings



- A) Scroll to WiFi.
- B) Look for your iPhone under Personal Hotspots (right hand side of your screen)
- C) **Touch** your iPhone's name to activate.

D) The Hotspot is activated if there is a blue checkmark next to your iPhone's name.

Note: to disconnect turn off the Hotspot on your iPhone and click OFF 'Allow Others to Join.

Step #2 - Mac Connection

Have your iPhone near with Personal Hotspot turned on (see Step One)

On your Mac laptop go to Settings



- A. Scroll to WiFi
- B. Look for your iPhone's hotspot to appear and hover your cursor over it. A Connect button will appear.
- C. Click Connect
- D. The Hotspot is activated if there is a checkmark next to your iPhone's name
